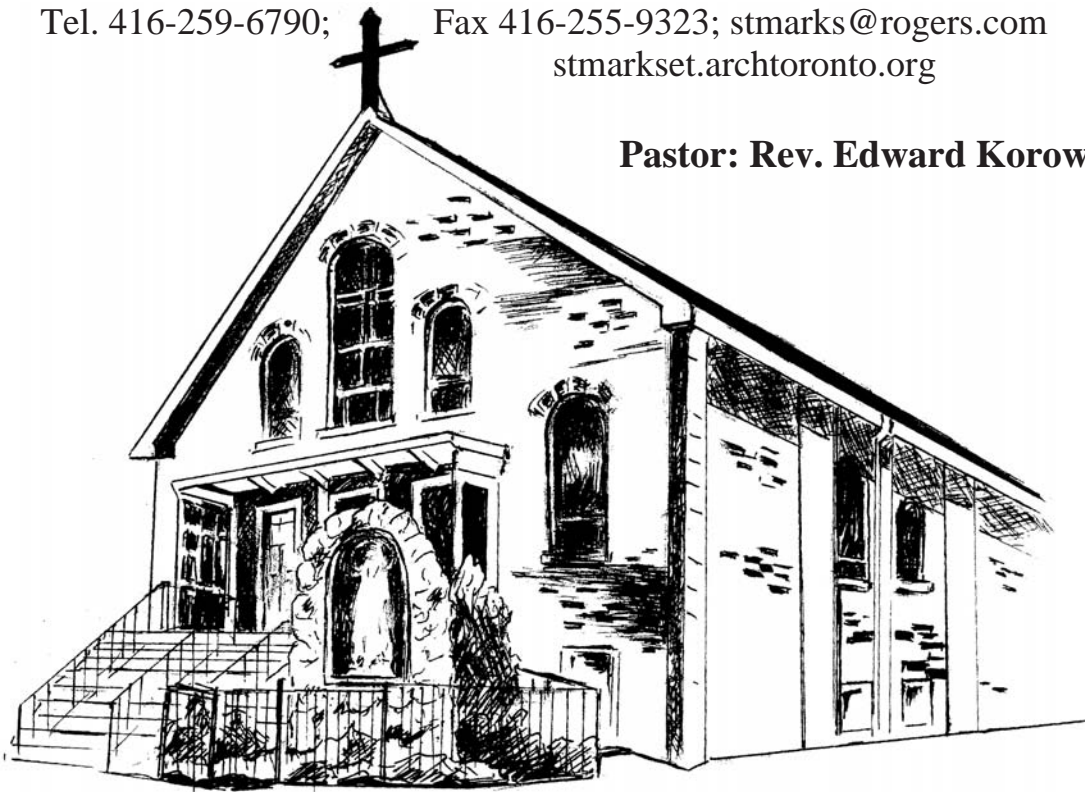

**FIRST FRIDAY:** Friday, November 2 is the First Friday of November. After the usual 9:00 a.m. Mass (in English), there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament throughout the day until 7:00 p.m., when there will be Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, followed by evening Mass at 7:10 p.m. (in Polish). **CONFESSIONS** will be heard from **6:00 to 6:45 p.m.**

**“COME AND SEE” VOCATION DISCERNMENT WEEKEND:** Friday, November 2 (6:30 p.m.) to Sunday, November 4 (1:30 p.m.). There will be an opportunity for young men 17 years and older to spend a weekend with time for prayer, reflection and information on the process of becoming a Catholic priest at St. Augustine's Seminary in Scarborough. Please speak with Fr. Koroway if you are interested.

**HOLY SOULS ENVELOPES** are available on the tables at the back of the Church for those who wish to make use of them. During the month of November, our Masses (except for the required weekly Sunday Mass for the Parishioners) will be offered for the repose of the souls of those whose names have been listed on the Holy Souls envelopes, which will be kept on the altar throughout the month.

**PRAYER OF ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL:** Cardinal Collins has asked that this prayer be recited after Mass, following the dismissal and before the closing hymn. The prayer was composed by Pope Leo XII. There are slight variations in different versions of the prayer, but we will eventually receive prayer cards with the version to use. In the meantime, we are using the version on the diocesan/parish website:

**Saint Michael Archangel**, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; may God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

**NOVEMBER 1, ALL SAINTS DAY:** In the Creed, we profess our belief in the “communion of Saints”. The Church is a spiritual communion composed of the saints in heaven, the holy souls in purgatory, and those of us here on earth. Through our baptism, we are the holy people of God, yet in constant need of being made holy, or purified. We sometimes refer to the above three components of the communion of saints as the Church triumphant (in heaven); the Church patient (in purgatory); and the Church militant (those of us here on earth, struggling to lead a holy life so we can one day join the saints in heaven).

Only a small number of holy men and women have been formally “canonized”, or declared saints by the Church. So on November 1, we honour the many saints in heaven whose number and name are known

by God alone. We hope and pray that one day we may join them there too.

On **November 2, All Souls Day**, we pray for the holy souls in purgatory. They are not yet in heaven. When they died, they were judged worthy of one day entering Christ's heavenly kingdom. Yet they are in need of purification for the sins which they committed which have not yet been forgiven, or for which satisfaction has not yet been made. On the one hand they are happy souls because they know that one day they will join Our Lord in heaven. Yet they suffer the pain of separation from his kingdom, and the pain for their past offences. But they are helped by the prayers we here on earth offer for them, especially on All Souls Day and throughout the month of November. Indeed, the Church prays for the souls of the faithful departed at every Mass.

*Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord.  
And let perpetual light shine upon them.  
May they rest in peace. Amen.*

**DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME** ends *next* weekend. Please remember to turn your clocks *back* one hour before retiring next Saturday evening (**November 3-4**). ("Spring ahead, fall back.")

## XXX Niedziela w ciągu roku – B

**UZDROWIENIE NIEWIDOMEGO.** Jezus jest w drodze do Jerozolimy. Droga ta kończy się według św. Marka uzdrowieniem ślepego z Jerycha. A uczniowie Jezusa ciągle są ślepi. Byli ślepych po rozmnożeniu chleba i będą nimi w czasie męki i śmierci Jezusa. Wtedy tylko pogański setnik będzie jedynym, który zrozumie i zawoła: „Ten człowiek był Synem Bożym!” (Mk15,35). Ślepy Bartymeusz, świadomy swego kalectwa, wołał o pomoc i został uzdrowiony. Naśladowanie powinno być dziełem mojej wiary, jako wyraz wdzięczności.

**PIERWSZY PIĄTEK:** 2-go listopada przypada pierwszy piątek miesiąca listopada. Po Mszy Św. o godzinie **9-iej** rano (po angielsku), będzie wystawienie Najświętszego Sakramentu do godziny **7-iej** wieczorem, i Błogosławieństwo. Po Błogosławieństwie, będzie dodatkowa Msza Św. po polsku (o godzinie **7:10**). Będzie też okazja do spowiedzi świętej od godziny **6:00 do 6:45**.

**WYPOMINKI:** Miesiąc listopad to miesiąc modlitwy za zmarłych. Podczas całego miesiąca listopada, każdego dnia Msze Św. będą odprawiane za zmarłych poleconych w wypominkach. Kopertki na ten cel są już wystawione przy wejściu do Kościoła.

**Święty Michale Archaniele**, wspomóż nas w walce, a przeciw niegodziwości i zasadzkom złego ducha bądź naszą obroną. Oby go Bóg pogromić raczył, pokornie o to prosimy, a Ty, Wodzu niebieskich zastępów, szatana i inne duchy złe, które na zgubę dusz ludzkich po tym świecie krążą, mocą Bożą strąć do piekła. Amen.
