INCOME TAX RECEIPTS FOR 2019 are being mailed or distributed to those whose total donations given in the parish were \$50 or more for 2019. (Those whose donations were over \$25 but under \$50 may obtain a receipt upon request.) The receipts are good for five years, in case you do not have enough income this year to benefit from the tax refund available. If married, either spouse may use the receipt, if you have the same address. In order to receive proper credit for your weekly donations, *please write the amount on the envelope each week.* Also, if you are a new user, please write your name and address on the first few envelopes.

We encourage everyone to use envelopes. Thev provide a record of your registration in the parish and attendance at Mass, should you require a sacramental or other reference letter at some stage. Blank envelopes for those who have not been using them this year are available at the back of the Church. (Please take the *whole* box—not just the first envelope.) They allow us to issue you a tax receipt for charitable donations. For total charitable donations (from all sources) of over \$200, you receive a combined federal (29.0 per cent) and provincial (11.16 per cent) tax credit of 40.16 per cent. This means for every \$100 you contribute, you get \$40.16 back on your tax payable when you file your income tax return. [The combined federal (15.0 per cent) and provincial (5.05 per cent) credit for total donations under \$200 is 20.05 per cent.]

Please note that any donations made to the Family of Faith campaign (or for ShareLife directly to the Chancery) will be receipted separately, from the Chancery, by the end of February.

Święto Chrztu Pańskiego

DAR CHRZTU ŚWIĘTEGO. Dziś, w święto Chrztu Pańskiego kończy się okres Bożego Narodzenia. Ewangelie zgodnie zaświadczają, że gdy Jezus wyszedł z wody, zstąpił na Niego Duch Święty w postaci gołębicy i z nieba zabrzmiał głos Ojca, który powiedział: "Ty jesteś mój Syn umiłowany, w Tobie mam upodobanie" (*Mk 1, 11*).

Jezus, wmieszany w tłum pokutników, poprosił Jana Chrzciciela o chrzest, czym głęboko zaskoczył Prekursora. Lecz to właśnie ten gest objawia szczególny rys mesjanizmu Jezusa: ma On wypełnić wolę Ojca, wydając się w "ofierze przebłagalnej za nasze grzechy" (1 J 4, 10). Pokorna solidarność z grzesznikami doprowadzi Go do śmierci na krzyżu. Zanurzenie w śmierci i zmartwychwstaniu Chrystusa jest radykalnym wyzwoleniem człowieka z grzechu i śmierci oraz stanowi nowe narodziny z Ducha do życia, które nie będzie miało końca.

Chrzest dzieci, w bardzo prosty i wymowny sposób pozwala nam pojąć prawdziwą naturę zbawienia. Jest ono łaską, czyli darmowym darem Pana. Dlatego rodzice chrześcijańscy powinni spieszyć ze swoimi dziećmi do chrzcielnicy, aby mogły one otrzymać na mocy wiary Kościoła wielki dar życia Bożego. Rodzice ci poprzez swój przykład, modlitwę i pouczenia mają też być pierwszymi wychowawcami w wierze swoich dzieci. [Św. Jan Paweł II]
