

CHURCH REOPENING GUIDELINES

- 1. If you are sick, have a fever, or are unwell, please stay home and get better. As a matter of charity, please do not come to church where you may spread your illness to someone else. The Cardinal has dispensed the faithful from Sunday Mass during the pandemic.
- 2. The government is limiting church seating to one-third of capacity, while maintaining physical distancing of **6 feet**. This reduces considerably the number of spaces available. We have taped off every second row in the Church, and marked with blue tape available seating in the remaining rows that is 6 feet apart. Members of the same household (e.g. couples and families with children) may sit together. In that case, anyone else in that row should sit 6 feet away, irrespective of where the blue tape mark may happen to be.
- 3. Because of the limited spaces available, seating will be on a first come, first served basis. It may mean that if all the available seating is occupied, you will not be able to attend that particular Mass. Remember that the Cardinal's dispensation from attending Sunday Mass continues during the pandemic.

- 4. You are asked to **bring a mask** to wear while in Church, for your protection and others to mitigate the potential spread of the virus. While not mandatory, a mask is highly recommended. Also, please use the **hand sanitizers** upon arrival.
- 5. There will be **no collection during Mass**, but you are encouraged to drop your donation into the donation baskets/boxes at the back of the Church either before or after Mass.
- 6. Singing by the congregation is not permitted, because it encourages projection of particles from the mouth, increasing the danger of transmission of disease. This is why we have been instructed to remove all hymnals from the pews (as well as all other papers, pamphlets, or envelopes). There will still be a cantor/organist to provide music on a solo basis. Bulletins will only be available online on our website: (stmarkset.archtoronto.org—select News and Events, then Bulletin Library), as we are not allowed to have printed materials people can touch in the church.
- 7. The **holy water** fonts remain empty. For the sign of peace, you may nod to your neighbour, but please **do not shake hands**.
- 8. For **Holy Communion**, please process in a single (not double) line, keeping a 6-foot distance from the person in front of you, following tape markings in the centre aisle. When you are next, stand 6 feet in front of the priest, who will say "The Body of Christ", and you answer "Amen". Then move forward to receive the host **in your hand**, holding one hand flat above the other. (Holy Communion on the tongue is not permitted during this time.) When you receive the host, step to the side, 6 feet, and then consume the host, before returning to your seat by the side aisle.

THANK YOU! to all who have been contributing to our parish by dropping off your envelopes at the rectory mail box, mailing them in, or donating online. For those who have not been able to do so, we invite you to make up for the weeks you have not donated because of the closure. As there is no collection

during Mass, you may leave your offerings in the baskets/boxes at the back of the Church or continue to drop them off, mail them in or donate online by **credit card**. [Just go to our parish website: **stmarkset.archtoronto.org**, and on the home page, click the orange quadrangle in the upper right hand corner (where there is a hand and a \$ sign). Then click "Your Parish", select the "Toronto West" region, then our parish (St. Mark's) in the drop down menu. You can make a one time or recurring contribution to our parish's offertory or building fund using your credit card.]

<u>VOLUNTEERS:</u> Finally, we invite you to consider how you might share your time and talents as a **volunteer**. We particularly need people willing to disinfect the benches and common touch points in between Masses, and ushers to direct people to their places. If you'd like to help, please let Fr. Koroway know.

MECZENNICY ZA WIARE. Odwieczne pytanie, jakie towarzyszy człowiekowi wierzącemu brzmi: Dlaczego ludzie dobrzy i sprawiedliwi muszą cierpieć? Na to pytanie nie ma prostej odpowiedzi. Właściwie jedyna możliwość, to odpowiedzieć pytaniami: Dlaczego Chrystus musiał cierpieć?; Czy Bóg nie miał innej możliwości odkupienia człowieka? Jeremiasz, podobnie jak wielu innych proroków Starego Testamentu, mimo swej wierności Bogu był prześladowany, ale się nie załamał. Wierzył, że jego niezłomna wierność ma sens. Osoba proroka jest figurą - zapowiedzią losu Mesjasza, który także musiał cierpieć, aby wejść do swej chwały (por. Łk 24, 26). Mimo że nic nie wskazywało na to, że jego sytuacja się zmieni, Jeremiasz w proroczej mowie Śpiewajcie Panu, wysławiajcie Pana! zacheca: Podobny los może spotkać każdego chrześcijanina. Jezus pociesza nas: Nie bójcie się tych, którzy zabijają ciało, lecz duszy zabić nie mogą (Mt 10, 28). Podczas dwudziestu wieków istnienia Kościoła nigdy nie brakowało męczenników za wiarę. Każdy z nas powinien być gotowy na drwiny i represje jako konsekwencje przyznania się do Chrystusa. Wtedy Chrystus przyzna się do nas przed swoim Ojcem. (o. Piotr R. Gryziec – franciszkanin)

Dzisiaj obchodzimy Dzien Ojców. Życzymy wszystkim Ojcom i Dziadkom dużo zdrowia i błogosławieństwa Bożego i Matki Najświętszej!


