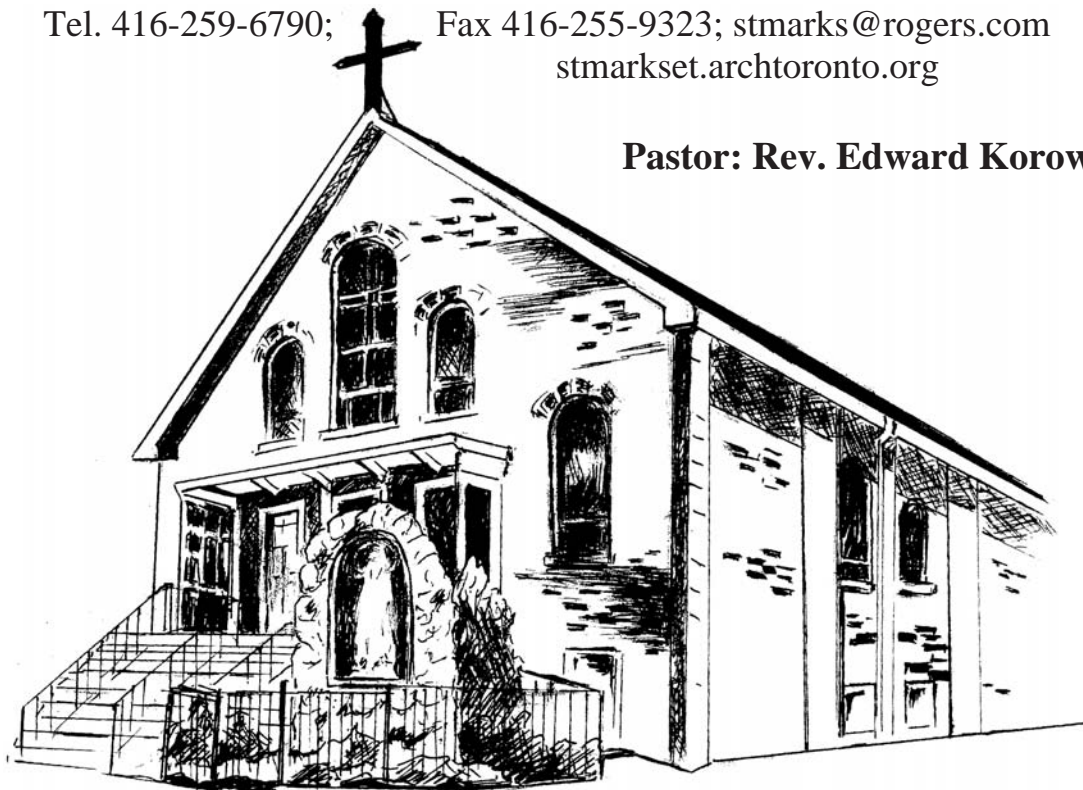

### CATHOLIC CEMETERIES ANNUAL MASS FOR THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED.

Due to current protocols surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, the Mass has been cancelled this year at our seven Catholic cemeteries. Cardinal Collins, will celebrate a special Mass via livestream for our faithful departed on **Wednesday, August 12, at 7:00 p.m.** from St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. **MARYTRS' SHRINE, MIDLAND:** It has been decided that Martyrs' Shrine will be closed this year, and so not be opening its Church, or its grounds, **until 1 May 2021.**

**THE DIVINE MERCY SHRINE** in Queensville will continue their summer pilgrimages Novena this year. Dates for this year's Novena are July 19 and 26, as well as August 2, 9, 16, 23 and 30. The program is as follows: Confession 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m.; Prayers 1:00 p.m.; Mass 2:00 p.m. Activities will take place outdoors with visitors physically distanced and wearing masks. Inclement weather will allow us to host only 50 people indoors. Anybody can join us via Zoom by e-mailing: [magnificatreginapc@gmail.com](mailto:magnificatreginapc@gmail.com). Location: From the 404: go two blocks east to Warden Avenue on Green Lane. Go north, cross Mt. Albert Side Rd. Slow down, see the big entrance sign to your right in 900 meters. ### CHURCH REOPENING GUIDELINES

1. If you are sick, have a fever, or are unwell, please stay home and get better. As a matter of charity, please do not come to church where you may spread your illness to someone else. The Cardinal has dispensed the faithful from Sunday Mass during the pandemic.
2. The government is limiting church seating to one-third of capacity, while maintaining physical distancing of **6 feet**. This reduces considerably the number of spaces available. We have taped off every second row in the Church, and marked with blue tape available seating in the remaining rows that is 6 feet apart. Members of the same household (e.g. couples and families with children) may sit together. In that case, anyone else in that row should sit 6 feet away, irrespective of where the blue tape mark may happen to be.
3. Because of the limited spaces available, **seating will be on a first come, first served basis.**
4. You are asked to **bring a Mask** to wear while in Church, for your protection and others to mitigate the potential spread of the virus. **A Mask or Face Covering which covers the nose, mouth and chin is now (from July 7) mandatory** (City of Toronto by-law.) Exceptions are for children under two years of age, or persons with an underlying medical condition which inhibits their ability to wear a mask or face covering, or persons who are unable to place or remove a Mask or Face Covering without assistance. Also, please use the **hand sanitizers** upon arrival.
5. There will be **no collection during Mass**, but you are encouraged to drop your donation into the donation baskets/boxes at the back of the Church either before or after Mass.
6. **Singing by the congregation is not permitted**, because it encourages projection of particles from the mouth, increasing the danger of transmission of disease. This is why we have been instructed to remove all hymnals from the pews (as well as all other papers, pamphlets, or envelopes). There will still be a cantor/organist to provide music on a solo basis. Bulletins will only be available online on our website: ([stmarkset.archtoronto.org](http://stmarkset.archtoronto.org)—select News and Events, then Bulletin Library), as we are not allowed to have printed materials people can touch in the church.

7. The **holy water** fonts remain empty. For the sign of peace, you may nod to your neighbour, but please **do not shake hands**.
8. For **Holy Communion**, please process in a single (not double) line, keeping a 6-foot distance from the person in front of you, following tape markings in the centre aisle. When you are next, stand 6 feet in front of the priest, who will say “The Body of Christ”, and you answer “Amen”. Then move forward, *with your mask still on*, to receive the host **in your hand**, holding one hand flat above the other. (Holy Communion on the tongue is not permitted during this time.) When you receive the host, step to the side, 6 feet, *remove your mask*, and then consume the host, *put your mask on again*, before returning to your seat by the side aisle.

**THANK YOU!** to all who have been contributing to our parish by dropping off your envelopes at the rectory mail box, mailing them in, or donating online. For those who have not been able to do so, we invite you to make up for the weeks you have not donated because of the closure. As there is no collection during Mass, you may leave your offerings in the baskets/boxes at the back of the Church or continue to drop them off, mail them in or donate online by **credit card**. ## **XVI-A Niedziela w ciągu roku**

**CIERPLIWOŚĆ BOGA.** Na propozycję sług, aby wyrwać chwast z pola, na którym rośnie także pszenica, gospodarz odpowiada: „Nie, byście zrywając chwast nie wyrwali z nim pszenicy. Pozwólcie obojgu rósć aż do żniwa!”. Zdumiewa nas wielka wyrozumiałość i cierpliwość gospodarza, będącego symbolem Boga, i Jego postawa wobec ludzkich słabości i grzechów.

Bóg przenika człowieka i zna go tak, że widzi jego intencje, wysiłki i czyny. Przez to najpełniej potrafi dostrzec w nim dobro. Pan nie posługuje się gwałtem i przemocą wobec zła w człowieku, by w ten sposób zarazem nie zniszczyć dobra. Bardzo wierzy w człowieka i w to, że moc dobra i dynamika jego wzrostu okaże się silniejsza, niż zło. Dlatego poleca: „Zło dobrem zwyciężaj!”.

Owa wyrozumiałość Boga, która nie oznacza tolerancji wobec zła, wynika z wielkiego poszanowania, jakie On ma wobec nas i naszej wolności. Woli sam znieść nasze zło, niż siłą zaingerować w naszą wolność i nasze czyny. Pragnie, byśmy mieli utkwiony wzrok w Chrystusa, który „przeszedł przez życie dobrze czyniąc” i przyjmując cierpliwie krzyż, pokonał zło, grzech i szatana.

Bóg wzywa nas do ponownego uwierzenia w moc dobra w naszym życiu. Najgłębszego źródła owej mocy nie szukajmy jednakże w nas, lecz w Chrystusie ukrzyżowanym i zmartwychwstałym. Odkrywajmy je na modlitwie osobistej i we wspólnocie eucharystycznej, w której On uobecnia się pośród nas w mocy swego Ducha. (ks. Stanisław Zarzycki – pallotyn)
