

**CARDINAL COLLINS** sent a letter recently on the state of emergency in Ontario. In it he writes: "It is our firm belief that spiritual sustenance is essential for the mental, spiritual and physical well-being of the faithful and the church offers essential support for many who are isolated or vulnerable. During this period of pandemic, churches in the archdiocese continue to offer livestream services and other creative outreach ministries for which I am most grateful. I also ask churches, that are able to do so safely, to continue to remain open for private prayer and, where feasible, to offer Holy Communion Services on weekends previously communicated... ...participation is limited to no more than 10 people inside the church at any given time. ..."

The Cardinal adds, "those who are symptomatic, have a compromised immune system or are at a greater risk of infection, should remain home".

With respect to Sanitizing Pews/Seating Areas, a recent update of the WorshipSafe guidelines for Catholic churches throughout the province was

conducted. In relation to the sanitization of seating areas in churches, the following updated direction should now be utilized:

If a pew will not be used within an hour of the last occupancy, there should be no need to disinfect, though periodic regular cleaning should still continue. Where the pew is scheduled to be used within an hour of last occupancy, disinfection should consist of running a disinfectant-laden cloth along the tops and sides of each pew. This approach is likely to be sufficient to combat pathogens, and as more research is done, such requirements may be eventually be dispensed with.

#### **Covid-19 Vaccine**

The Cardinal writes: "We pray that the vaccination process that has recently commenced in Canada and around the world will greatly contribute to a swift end to the pandemic. We long for the day where, once again, we may return, without restrictions, to full and active participation in the Eucharist, the source and summit of our spiritual journey. I encourage Catholics in the Archdiocese of Toronto to be vaccinated at the appropriate time, given the distribution plans outlined by the relevant authorities. ...

"Thank you for your steadfast faith and ongoing prayers during these very challenging days. I ask you especially to keep close in prayer the many elderly and vulnerable people who have succumbed to the Covid-19 virus, those who are sick and those who care for them. I recognize that the current restrictions are incredibly frustrating for all of us. Out of love for one another, we must make every effort to combat this deadly pandemic that has taken the lives of so many, both here at home and around the world. May God continue to bless you now and always."

FISHING FOR CHRIST. "Come follow me and I will make you fishers of people." Just as Jesus called his first disciples 2000 years ago, he continues to call us to follow him. As we reflect on this beautiful Gospel account, let us focus on one particular aspect, the fact that Jesus uses the image of being a "fisher." It is most interesting to note that as he is calling actual fishermen, he uses their own language.

There is a deep spiritual insight that can be gleaned from this, namely, that Christ uses what we bring to the table to serve Him and the Church. While fishing may seem unrelated to being an apostle, Jesus does not downplay their past experience. He invites them to bring all of the gifts and talents that they've received from God, but instead of using it for their own gain, to use it to gain souls for Christ.

So too as stewards, we can sometimes think that God can only use us if we're already perfect disciples, or have degrees in theology or extensive training in ministry. However, the Lord wants us to bring all of our experiences, even our personal and professional backgrounds to serve Him. ... This is the heart of stewardship. To recognize that we all bring our own particular gifts that can be used to serve Christ. Let us reflect on our own gifts and graciously heed the call to become "fishers of people," each in our own way. (www.archtoronto.org/stewardship)

#### III Niedziela w ciągu roku – B

Wyjątkowe Królestwo. Nauka o królestwie Bożym zajmuje centralne miejsce w nauczaniu Chrystusa. W osobie Jezusa Bóg przychodzi do ludzi i chce królować w ich sercach. Na tyle "bliskie jest królestwo Boże", na ile Bóg w Chrystusie zbliżył się do ludzkiego serca. Królestwo Boże posiada swoją specyfikę i różni się zdecydowanie od jakiegokolwiek ziemskiego królestwa. Jego wyjątkowość wyraża się w tym, że ma ono przeniknąć do wnętrza człowieka, opanować jego myśli, uczucia i pragnienia. Oznacza to, że królestwo Boże musi najpierw zaistnieć w sercu człowieka, aby on przez całą wieczność mógł korzystać z jego duchowego bogactwa.

Aby serce człowieka mogło stać się królestwem Bożym, konieczne jest jego nawrócenie, które nie może dokonać się bez głębokiej wiary w Ewangelię. Serce ludzkie zyskuje wtedy nową godność, staje się uprzywilejowaną przestrzenią królowania Boga. Konkretnym wyrazem obecności królestwa Bożego w sercu człowieka jest pójście za Chrystusem, stanie się Jego uczniem przez naśladowanie Jego postawy.

Bóg, powołując ludzi, pragnie swoim słowem nieustannie pielęgnować w nich swoje królestwo. Największym szczęściem człowieka jest odczucie, że "czas się wypełnił" i jego serce nie doświadczy już więcej pustki, bo sam Bóg objął w nim królowanie. Wszyscy oczekujemy na udział w królestwie Ojca u kresu dziejów, wierzący jednak zanim spoczną w królestwie niebieskim, nie przestają wołać, powtarzając bezustannie: "Przyjdź królestwo Twoje!" — przyjdź do mojego serca. 
