

<u>Celebrating the Stewardship of Others.</u> In today's readings we learn the importance of having the right attitude and disposition in our approach towards stewardship. A steward is called to live in humility. We are not the owners of our gifts but are simply the humble caretakers of them and it is our job to give them back to God with increase.

St. James in the second reading says, "Where there is envy and selfish ambition, there will also be disorder and wickedness of every kind." As stewards, we will often face the temptation to compare our gifts with those of others. It is a human reaction to seek recognition for our good works and want to be rewarded. However, the goal of stewardship is not our own glory, but rather the glory of Christ and the Church. One way to combat envy and ambition is to intentionally celebrate the talents of others. Since we are all one Body of Christ, the gifts of our brothers and sisters are the gifts of the whole Church.

... in the Gospel today Jesus instructs His apostles saying, "Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all." True stewards seek to serve others before themselves. ... Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation is *tentatively* scheduled to be administered in our parish on **Saturday, April 23, 2022,** at the **5:00 p.m.** Mass. Students in *Grade 7 or older*, and any adults who wish to be confirmed should attend one of the weekend Masses, and obtain a registration form from Fr. Koroway afterwards. The form lists the dates of the three preparation meetings the candidates and their parents must attend on Saturday mornings in the Church. The deadline for returning the registration forms is **Sunday, November 14.**

XXV Niedziela w ciągu roku-B

<u>Ze względu na Chrystusa stać się ostatnim.</u> Ewangelista opisuje wyraźny przykład rozbieżności pomiędzy myślami i drogami Bożymi a ludzkimi: oto gdy Jezus, zmierzając z Apostołami do Jerozolimy, zapowiada im czekającą Go tam mękę i krzyż, oni w tym czasie spierają się pomiędzy sobą o to, kto z nich jest największy.

Czy owa rozbieżność myślenia i postępowania względem Jezusa nie uwidacznia się niejednokrotnie i w życiu człowieka dzisiaj? Lansowany styl życia zdominowany pogonią za tym, by więcej mieć i żyć coraz bardziej komfortowo oraz by bardziej być, gdy się zdobędzie intratne stanowisko, wyższy stopień naukowy, większy prestiż u innych i władzę nad nimi — może skłaniać człowieka do zazdrości, zawiści i wyzwalać w nim przesadne ambicje.

W owej pogoni za własną wielkością, jakże cenne jest napomnienie Chrystusa: "Jeśli kto chce być pierwszym, niech będzie ostatnim ze wszystkich i sługa wszystkich" (Mk 9,35). "Ostatnie" miejsce nie jest tak naprawdę ostatnim, gdyż upodabnia człowieka do Jezusa, który dla nas i dla naszego zbawienia stał się ostatnim, przyjmując śmierć krzyżową, mimo że taki rodzaj śmierci był zadawany z wielką pogardą i przeznaczony niewolnikom czy buntownikom. Pójście za Jezusem domaga się od każdego Jego ucznia tego, by pragnął być ostatnim, by to pragnienie uczynił swym ideałem i z tej racji wyrzekł się swego niewłaściwego "ja" zdominowanego różnymi namietnościami, i by umiał dostrzegać wokół siebie tych, co są uważani za ostatnich, gdyż są słabi, bezbronni, ubodzy, a czasami zagubieni w życiu.

Dzisiaj zbierana będzie druga składka przeznaczona na fundusz renowacyjny Kościoła. Specjalne koperty niebieskie na ten cel są wyłożone na stolikach przy wejściu do Kościoła. Zebrane fundusze zostaną przeznaczone na wiele projektów remontowych, którymi należy się zająć w naszej parafii, a także na zmniejszenie naszego zadłużenia z dobudowy windy. Z góry bardzo wam dziękujemy za ofiary przeznaczone na ten cel. Bóg zapłać, i niech was Bóg błogosławi!

Święty Michale Archaniele, wspomagaj nas w walce, a przeciw niegodziwości i zasadzkom złego ducha bądź naszą obroną. Oby go Bóg pogromić raczył, pokornie o to prosimy, a Ty, Wodzu niebieskich zastępów, szatana i inne duchy złe, które na zgubę dusz ludzkich po tym świecie krążą, mocą Bożą strąć do piekła. Amen.


