MARRIAGE (from The Cathechism of the Catholic

Church): 1660. The marriage covenant, by which a man and a woman form with each other an intimate communion of life and love, has been founded and endowed with its own special laws by the Creator. By its very nature it is ordered to the good of the couple, as well as to the generation and education of children. Christ the Lord raised marriage between the baptized to the dignity of a sacrament.

1661. The sacrament of Matrimony signifies the union of Christ and the Church. It gives spouses the grace to love each other with the love with which Christ has loved his Church; the grace of the sacrament thus perfects the human love of the spouses, strengthens their indissoluble unity, and sanctifies them on the way to eternal life.

<u>VI Niedziela w ciągu roku – C</u>

ZASKAKUJĄCA MIŁOŚĆ. Liturgia Słowa mówi dziś o błogosławieństwie. Każdy człowiek pragnie być kimś błogosławionym i szczęśliwym. Każdy też ryzykuje, że będzie szukał szczęścia tam, gdzie go nie ma. Przeklęty jest ten, kto pokłada nadzieję w człowieku albo we własnej cielesności (I czytanie). Chrystus przestrzega przed pogonią za doczesnymi bogactwami i zaszczytami (*zob. Łk 6, 2-26*). Taka pogoń to droga egoizmu i krótkowzroczności, która zawsze prowadzi do rozczarowania i cierpienia. Syn Boży wskazuje nam nieomylną - i właśnie dlatego trudną! - drogę do szczęścia. Błogosławieni ci, którzy czynią sprawiedliwość, którzy są uczciwi i wytrwali. Błogosławieni nawet wtedy, gdy są prześladowani czy płaczą.

Radość to przecież nie to samo, co przyjemność, a błogosławieństwo to nie to samo, co doraźny sukces. Nie ma błogosławieństwa bez patrzenia w głab człowieka, tajemnicy bez rozumienia historii zbawienia (II czytanie), bez pokładania nadziei w Jego madrości Bogu, W i miłości (psalm responsoryjny). Owocem pójścia droga błogosławieństwa Chrystusa jest radość i pokój, jakich ten świat dać nie może! Na początku Eucharystii staję dzisiaj wobec pytania: Na jakiej drodze szukam błogosławieństwa - na drodze egoizmu czy miłości? (ks. Marek Dziewiecki)

Błogosławieni wy, którzy teraz płaczecie, albowiem śmiać się będziecie (Łk 6, 21)

Święty Michale Archaniele, wspomagaj nas w walce, a przeciw niegodziwości i zasadzkom złego ducha bądź naszą obroną. Oby go Bóg pogromić raczył, pokornie o to prosimy, a Ty, Wodzu niebieskich zastępów, szatana i inne duchy złe, które na zgubę dusz ludzkich po tym świecie krążą, mocą Bożą strąć do piekła.
