

**GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY:** The Fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally known as Good Shepherd Sunday, as we always hear the Gospel which presents Jesus as the Good Shepherd. It is also the annual World Day of Prayer for vocations.

**ATTENDING TO OUR PRIMARY VOCATION.**

This Sunday is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. As disciples, we all share one common vocation, the vocation of holiness. The Second Vatican Council says “that all the faithful of Christ of whatever rank or status, are called to the fullness of the Christian life and to the perfection of charity.” (*Lumen Gentium* 40).

We cannot become holy and virtuous by our own merits. Rather, any growth is the result of the grace of God. We can receive numerous graces whenever we turn to him in quiet times of prayer as well as through the sacraments. The greatest form of prayer we can partake in is the Holy Mass. Consequently, we should strive to make it the highlight of our week, ensuring there are no competing distractions for our time. We can also, to the best of our circumstances, try to attend Mass on weekdays as well.

It is only when we are attending to our primary vocation of holiness that we'll be able to discern our secondary call to the vocation of priesthood, religious life, marriage or consecrated singlehood. Holiness will

allow us to have the humility and docility to hear the voice of God gently guiding us. It will also strengthen us to overcome any fears and say yes to whichever vocation He calls us to. Let us strive to live out our vocation of holiness to the best of our ability.

**A Meditation**

**By Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman**

God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission—I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next.

I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good, I shall do His work, I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place *while not intending it*—if I do but keep His Commandments.

Therefore I will trust Him. Whatever, wherever I am, I can never be thrown away. If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve Him; in perplexity, my perplexity may serve Him; if I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve Him. He does nothing in vain. He knows what He is about. He may take away my friends, He may throw me among strangers. He may make me feel desolate, make my spirits sink, hide my future from me—still He knows what He is about.

**Saint Michael the Archangel**, defend us in battle; be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray. And do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

#### **IV Niedziela Wielkanocna – C** **Niedziela Dobrego Pasterza**

**CZY DAJE SIĘ PROWADZIĆ JEZUSOWI?** W Niedzielę Dobrego Pasterza prosimy Pana o dwie rzeczy – o łaskę nowych powołań, kapłańskich i zakonnych, oraz o to, aby powołani byli pasterzami według Serca Dobrego Pasterza. Stawiamy też dwa pytania. Czy słuchamy głosu Boga i idziemy za Nim? Czy słuchamy tych, którzy uobecniają Boga tu na ziemi?

Pan pragnie zbawić każdego człowieka. Pouczył nas o tym Jezus Chrystus, kiedy polecił swym uczniom, aby szli na krańce świata i głosili Ewangelię wszelkiemu stworzeniu (por. Mk 16,15). W szczególny sposób nakaz ten realizował św. Paweł, do którego Chrystus powiedział: „Ustanowiłem cię światłością dla pogan, abyś był zbawieniem aż po krańce ziemi” (I czytanie). Apostoł Narodów pełnił swe posłannictwo najpierw wśród Żydów, głosząc im słowo Boże i zachęcając do wytrwania w łasce Boga, a następnie wśród pogan. Dzięki posłudze św. Pawła, doskonałego naśladowcy Chrystusa, Dobrego Pasterza, ci, którzy otworzyli się na słowo Boże i łaskę Boga, przyodziewali się w białe szaty, stając się ludem Pana i Jego owczarnią (II czytanie).

Jezus Chrystus, Dobry Pasterz, chce, aby Jego „owce” szły za Nim i słuchały Jego głosu. Pragnie, aby pełniły Jego wolę, naśladowały Go i upodabniały się do Niego. Jezus chce, abyśmy posiadli życie wieczne i nie zginęli na wieki (Ewangelia). Dlatego posyła nam głosiceli Bożej prawdy i szafarzy Bożej łaski.

Prośmy Pana, aby dał nam pasterzy, którzy, podobnie jak św. Paweł, będą mieli serca według Serca Dobrego Pasterza. Aby nigdzie nie brakowało tych, którzy będą służyć Jego owcom, w Jego owczarni. (ks. Waldemar Seremak – pallotyn)

Składając ofiarę w kopercie, możemy otrzymać pokwitowanie do podatku dochodowego od darowizny na cele charytatywne. Zaświadczenia podatkowe za każdy rok są wysyłane w styczniu.

Jeżeli nie zwiększyłeś regularnej tygodniowej sumy/kwoty darowizny przez dłuższy czas, być może mógłbyś to rozważyć teraz, ponieważ inflacja z każdym rokiem jest większa, a wydatki/koszty utrzymania nie maleją. Dziękujemy!


