

FORGIVING AND BEING FORGIVEN. The central mystery woven throughout the readings this Sunday is the need to forgive others. In today's Gospel we hear the parable of the wicked servant who although he was greatly forgiven of his large debt could not forgive the small debt of his fellow servant. This parable can be summarized by the words found in the Our Father, "forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us."

The Catechism teaches us that unless we forgive those in our lives, we cannot fully experience God's forgiveness. It says that "in refusing to forgive our brothers and sisters, our hearts are closed and their hardness makes them impervious to the Father's merciful love; but in confessing our sins, our hearts are opened to his grace" (CCC 2840)

So as stewards we should strive to forgive those who have hurt us, but how do we do this? The essential answer is prayer. The Catechism plainly states that "it is not in our power not to feel or to forget an offense; but the heart that offers itself to the Holy Spirit turns injury into compassion and purifies the memory in transforming the hurt into intercession" (CCC 2843). So ...we must intentionally choose to pray for our debtor and for the grace to forgive them. This is a difficult process and is sure to not happen overnight. Let us take some time daily, starting today, to pray for those who've hurt us. (source: archtoronto.org/stewardship)

Koroway afterwards. The form lists the dates of the three preparation meetings the candidates and their parents must attend on Saturday mornings in the Church. The deadline for returning the registration form is **Sunday**, **November 12**.

XXIV-A Niedziela w ciągu roku

SPRAWIEDLIWOŚĆ. Gdyby Bóg wyrównywał rachunki z ludźmi według tego, co każdemu się należy, sytuacja wielu osób byłaby tragiczna. Jak moglibyśmy spłacić Panu rachunek za zło uczynione w naszym życiu? Bylibyśmy bankrutami bez szansy na wyjście z długów.

Pan Bóg ukazuje jednak swoją dobroć. Posługuje się przykładem ogromnego kontrastu. W dzisiejszej Ewangelii opowiada o dwóch dłużnikach. Pierwszy był winien panu 10,000 talentów. Jest to kwota niewyobrażalna dla zwykłego śmiertelnika, szacowana, w naszych realiach, na wiele milionów złotych. Pan darował ten dług. Człowiek obdarzony tak wielką łaską nie odpuścił jednak swojemu współsłudze należności 100 denarów (czyli 100 dniówek robotnika). Ten, kto prosił o miłosierdzie, nie miał go dla bliźniego.

Pan nie godzi się na takie postępowanie. Chce, żebyśmy przebaczali nie 7 i nie 77 razy, ale zawsze. Biblijna "siódemka" jest przecież liczbą pełni. Nie można stawiać limitów w przebaczaniu. Skrupulatnie sumować sytuacji, kiedy przebaczyłem, i oczekiwać dnia, kiedy już nie będę musiał tego robić. Złość, gniew i pomsta nie znajdują uznania w oczach Pana (I czytanie).

Z czym więc zostajemy? Z wezwaniem od Boga, aby być takimi jak On – łaskawymi i pełnymi miłosierdzia (Psalm). Raczej nie musimy szukać specjalnej okazji ku temu, abyśmy mogli stać się właśnie tacy. Może nawet dziś będzie ku temu okazja? Pan Bóg przypomina nam o tym, że należymy do Niego, że nie żyjemy dla siebie samych (II czytanie). Nie warto więc rachować zysków i strat w relacji z innymi. Warto być dobrym jak Bóg, który odda każdemu sprawiedliwość. (ks. Marek Piedziewicz)

Dzisiaj odbędzie się druga zbiórka na fundusz remontowy kościoła. Specjalne niebieskie koperty w tym celu umieszczane są na stołach przy wejściu do kościoła. Zebrane środki zostaną przeznaczone na wiele projektów remontowych, którymi trzeba się zająć w naszej parafii, a także zmniejszenie zadłużenia (obecnie \$20,000) z nowego dachu dla kościoła i plebanii. *Dziękuję za Twoje wsparcie!*


