

FIRST FRIDAY: Friday, October 6 is the First Friday of September. After the usual 9:00 a.m. Mass (in English), there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until 3:00 p.m. The Church will reopen at 6:00 p.m. for Confessions until 6:45 p.m., followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:00 p.m., and evening Mass at 7:10 p.m. (in Polish).

INDIGENOUS HEALING & RECONCILATION COLLECTION. There will be a special collection this weekend to support the Indigenous Healing and Reconciliation Fund. The fund will support both local and national programs proposed by Indigenous communities to nurture the ongoing reconciliation journey. To date, the fund has raised close to 40 per cent of the \$30 million target as pledged by the Canadian bishops. The archdiocese will contribute \$6 million towards the national pledge. Yellow envelopes are available at the back of the Church for this purpose.

SEEKING TO SERVE RATHER THAN BE SERVED. In today's second reading St. Paul offers us a radical way of living as Christians. He says that we should humbly, "regard others as better than yourselves. Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the

interests of others." While this is a challenging way of life, it is at the very heart of being a steward.

To fully live with other people's interests above our own we require a dramatic interior conversion. Our society propagates the importance of the unholy trinity of "me, myself and I". In order to begin this conversion we need to turn to prayer and seek to imitate Jesus, the true steward. Jesus always sought to be a servant of others instead of demanding to be served. This was shown very poignantly when he washed the feet of the apostles. In this image, we see what it means to be a steward. To humble ourselves before others and seek their good before our own.

Imagine a parish community where everyone strives to serve their brothers and sisters. This service can be manifested in a variety of ways, whether it be simply going out of our way to say hello to a new family in the parish or supporting a family undergoing a major change or crises in their life. Let us constantly renew our commitment to being stewards and seek to serve rather than be served. (source: archtoronto.org/stewardship)

XXVI-A Niedziela w ciągu roku

WIARA OTWIERA BRAMY KRÓLESTWA.

Bardzo dobrze pamiętamy słowa Jezusa, że nierządnice i celnicy będą w raju przed nami. Zbytnio nas one nie szokują, a już na pewno nie gorszą tak, jak musiały gorszyć sprawiedliwych i pobożnych żydów, arcykapłanów i starszych ludu. Gdybyśmy jednak w miejsce "jawnogrzesznic i celników" wstawili naszych osobistych wrogów albo ludzi, których z różnych powodów nie lubimy, to być może nasze zachowanie byłoby podobne do reakcji faryzeuszy. Jak to? On lub ona przede mną?

Kto nie potrafi dostrzec, że jest człowiekiem grzesznym, niezasługującym na niebo, nie będzie też w stanie przyjąć łaski miłosierdzia. Jezus nikogo nie odsyła od bram nieba. Daje jedynie pierwszeństwo tym, którzy nawracając się, nie kryją, że są grzesznikami.

Na naszą grzeszność możemy patrzeć dwojako: bezbożnie i z wiarą. Bezbożnie, czyli zapominając o Bogu, którego miłosierdzie jest większe niż każdy, nawet najgorszy, najbardziej krępujący i zawstydzający nas grzech lub – z wiarą, która pozwala dostrzec w bolesnym doświadczeniu własnej słabości nieogarnioną łaskawość Boga. Mój grzech nie sprawia, że Chrystus ode mnie odchodzi, wycofuje się zatrwożony moją niegodziwością. To ja, grzesznik, odwracam się od Niego i próbuję iść swoją własną drogą. Jednak nawet wtedy Chrystus nie odstępuje mnie ani na krok, bo przecież sam zapewniał, że nie przyszedł wzywać do nawrócenia sprawiedliwych, ale grzeszników, że nie zdrowi, lecz chorzy potrzebują lekarza.(o. 
