

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK: FEBUARY 11: The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. February 11 (Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be administered after the 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday, February 10. It may be administered to anyone over 7 years of age who begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age (anyone over 65 can receive it). It is intended for those suffering from serious ilness, which can include physical, mental or spiritual illness.

<u>CELEBRATION OF MARRIAGE MASS WITH ARCHBISHOP LEO:</u> Sunday, February 11, 3:00 p.m. On the second Sunday of February each year, the Archdiocese of Toronto celebrates Marriage Sunday.

This occasion highlights the importance of the institution of marriage rooted in faith, affirms couples who strengthen our faith community through their witness, and complements World Marriage Sunday celebrations that take place across North America.

As part of Marriage Sunday 2024 celebrations, Archbishop Francis Leo will preside at a special Mass to honour married couples, with special recognition for those celebrating 25<sup>th</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, 60<sup>th</sup> and 60+ wedding anniversaries in 2024. The Mass will take place at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (65 Bond St., Toronto). All married couples will have an opportunity to renew their marriage commitment during the Mass.

All are welcome to attend. Reserved seating is available for couples celebrating a 25<sup>th</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup>, 60<sup>th</sup> or 60+ anniversary in 2024. Reserved seating is limited, so please register early. All other seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. Those who are unable to attend at the Cathedral are invited to join the celebration via livestream Mass. Registration and other important information can be found at www.archtoronto.org/marriage.

**REFLECT.** This Sunday, one central theme that runs through all of the readings is that of evangelization. St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians says "woe to me if I do not proclaim the Gospel!" At the end of the Gospel reading today it says that "Jesus went throughout Galilee proclaiming the message in their synagogues." St. Francis Xavier says that "many, many people hereabouts are not becoming Christians for one reason only: there is nobody to make them Christians." As stewards, evangelization is one of our core responsibilities so let us take some time to reflect on how we can offer our time and talents to this important work.

Firstly, in order for us to encourage people to follow Christ, we must take the time to journey with them. This is perhaps the most important gift we can offer someone as we evangelize. Jesus often spent His time conversing and interacting with the people of Judea. We too should follow this practice and intentionally make an effort to spend time with those whom we know are away from the faith. It is in these interactions that they will be able to see the joy and love that emanates from the presence of Christ within us.

Secondly, as stewards we are invited to perform concrete actions to help bring others to Christ. St. Teresa of Avila says that "we must all try to be preachers through our

deeds." By performing selfless acts of love we can point others to Love Himself and help them come to know Jesus. Therefore, as stewards, let us take the time and effort to intentionally share the Gospel through our daily witness. (source: archtoronto.org/stewardship)

**PERSPEKTYWY.** Raz po raz przekonujemy się o tym, jak bardzo trudne jest życie. Jednak pesymizm, jaki rodzi zetknięcie się z cierpieniem i śmiercią, nie jest do końca uzasadniony. Wierząc, wiemy, że jest Ktoś, na Kogo możemy zawsze liczyć.

Skargę Hioba na marność życia, przemijania i beznadziei podzielają miliony ludzi na świecie, którzy codziennie walczą o przetrwanie. Zmagają się z upokarzającą nędzą, chorobami, śmiercią, wrogością i odrzuceniem ze strony innych. Cierpieniem spowodowanym brakiem poczucia sensu życia.
