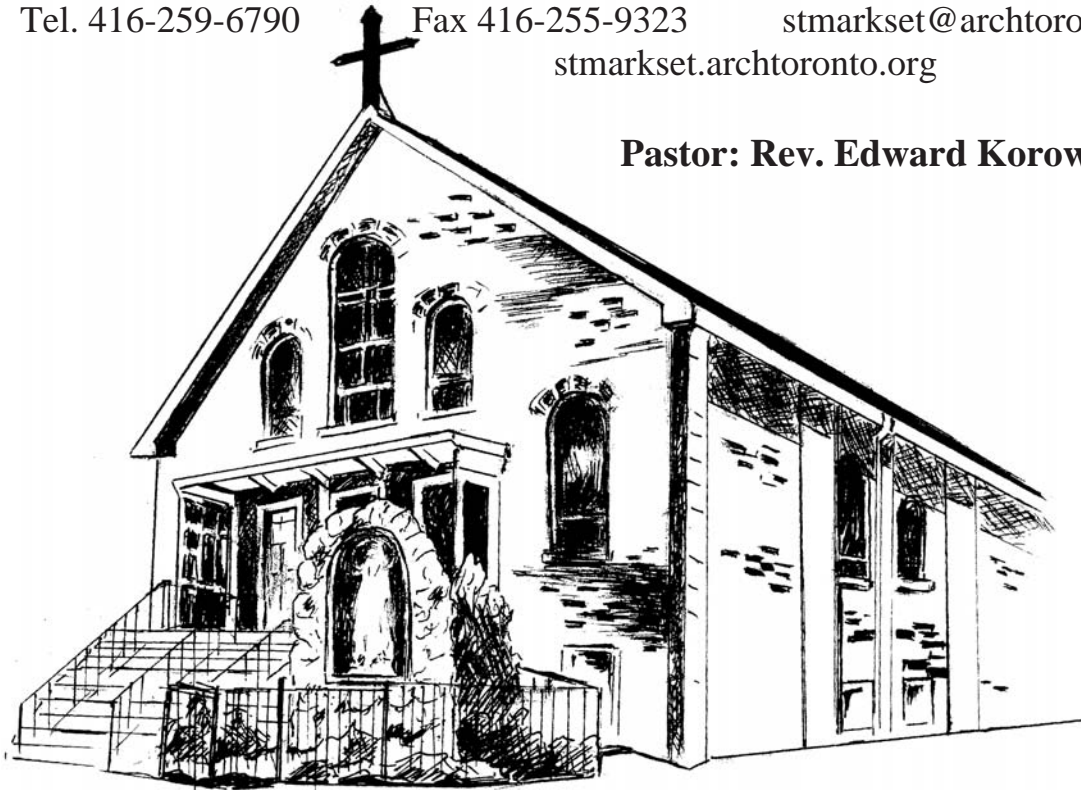

### **SIGNING OURSELVES WITH THE TRINITY.**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Catechism says that the "mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life ... It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith" (CCC 234). As Christians, we profess the mystery of the Trinity every time we make the sign of the cross, in the name of the Father, and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The practice of signing ourselves with the cross is an ancient tradition that likely dates back to the time of the Apostles. Around the year 200, Tertullian wrote that "we Christians wear out our foreheads with the sign of the cross." By signing ourselves, we are joining the countless saints that have gone before us. We can be a witness to the world whenever we sign ourselves in public. For example,

the next time we eat in public let us strive to make the sign of the cross as we pray our grace before meals.

Additionally, often times the sign of the cross is the quickest prayer we can muster in times of great stress. St. Francis de Sales, Doctor of the Church, recommends that we "make spiritual aspirations to God by short, ardent movements of [our] hearts." We can do this by invoking all three persons of the Trinity and marking ourselves with the cross, which is the sign of our salvation. Therefore, the next time we experience a difficult moment let us not despair but boldly make the sign of the cross. This will allow us to continually raise up our minds and hearts to the Blessed Trinity, the greatest mystery of our faith.

**THEOLOGY SUMMER SCHOOL—ORATORY OF**

**ST. PHILIP NERI.** The first week, **July 1 to 5**, of the Summer School is a systematic introduction to *The Catechism of the Catholic Church*. The five-day course has three lectures per day that provide a solid foundation for navigating the Catechism on one's own, either for personal reading or for use in home schooling, RCIA courses, or Catholic schools. The topic for the second week, **July 8 to 12**, is *Evangelizing the Modern World*. It is recommended that students take the first session before taking the second but not required.

In both weeks, lectures will be at 8:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and 1:15 p.m. EST, with Mass at 10:00 a.m. Lunch is provided for those attending in person. The course will also be available online. Those enrolled in the course can attend live through Zoom, and recordings will be made available for one week after the completion of the course to allow those whose schedules won't allow them to attend live to watch the classes. **Uroczystość Trójcy Przenajświętszej - rok B**

**PRAWDA O BOGU CHRZEŚCIJAN.** Kim jest Bóg, w którego wierzę? Odpowiedzi na to pytanie szukali ludzie od zarania dziejów. Z pomocą przyszedł sam Bóg. W słowach i czynach swojego Syna objawił nam nie tylko wielkie miłosierdzie Stwórcy, Jego miłość i troskę o każdego człowieka, ale też istotę Boga. Z nauki Jezusa dowiadujemy się, że Bóg jest jeden, posiada boską naturę, ale jest w trzech Osobach. Bóg chrześcijan to Ojciec, Syn i Duch Święty. Bóg Ojciec jest całkowicie niezależny w istnieniu i działaniu. Syn Boży jest współistotny Ojcu i przez relację synostwa pochodzi od Ojca. Duch Święty pochodzi od Ojca i Syna. Trzy Osoby w Bogu współprzenikają się i są równe w działaniu.

Prawda o Trójcy Świętej, ujęta w dogmat wiary katolickiej, nie jest tylko przedmiotem teologicznych i filozoficznych spekulacji. W dzisiejszej Ewangelii Zmartwychwstały Pan w pozdrowieniu skierowanym do Kościoła objawia nam Trójcę Świętą jako Nieskończoną Miłość, która od tajemnicy boskiej rozprzestrzenia się na naturę człowieka i w Kościele zajmuje jedno z uprzywilejowanych miejsc wyrazu. W imię Ojca i Syna, i Ducha Świętego dokonuje się zbawienie człowieka. Dlatego dziś gorąco prosimy Boga, aby wiara w Świętą Trójcę posłużyła nam do zbawienia duszy i ciała. (ks.
