YOU ARE WHAT YOU EAT. We celebrate today the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ – Corpus Christi. The Eucharist is the centre of the Mass and of our entire Catholic faith. St. Padre Pio said that "it would be easier for the world to survive without the sun than to do without Holy Mass." Let us spend some time reflecting on the Eucharist so that we can echo St. Padre Pio and come to a greater understanding of the beauty of the Mass.

Let us first contemplate what took place 2000 years ago on Good Friday. Jesus' death on the cross is what won for us our salvation. It was the event that defeated Satan and opened wide the gates of Heaven so that we who seek to follow Him can enter into that eternal rest. St. Thomas Aquinas says that "the celebration of Holy Mass is as valuable as the death of Jesus on the cross." If we are able to understand just how extraordinary Jesus' crucifixion was, so too, each and every Mass opens us up to abundant grace and healing.

Moreover, the Mass allows us to receive the very Body of Jesus and in doing so, become who we consume. We become another Christ in this world. As stewards, our goal is to imitate Jesus as closely as possible so that we can more fully share of our time and talents with our parish community. ...

<u>Uroczystość Bożego Ciała - rok B</u>

NAJŚWIĘTSZY Z CUDÓW. Eucharystia jest największym z cudów dokonanych przez Chrystusa. Aby umocnić nas w trudach ziemskiego pielgrzymowania, pozostawił nam znak swojej obecności w misterium swojego Ciała i swojej Krwi - byśmy mogli Go lepiej zrozumieć i pokochać. W Eucharystii obecny jest Bóg, który pierwszy ukochał, Bóg cichy i pokorny. Bóg, który chce, abyśmy pamiętali, że wielkość chrześcijaństwa to miłość i służba braciom. Jeśli w najbiedniejszym nie potrafisz rozpoznać Chrystusa, to nie potrafisz Go dostrzec w Eucharystii, ponieważ jedna i ta sama wiara rozświetla te same misteria (*Matka Teresa z Kalkuty*).

Kościół jest wspólnotą pielgrzymującą, wspólnotą ludzi zmierzających do pełnego zjednoczenia z Chrystusem. Jest wspólnotą, do której Bóg przemawiał na wiele sposobów (*por. Hbr 1, 1*) i teraz przemawia przez swego Syna, który jest obecny wśród nas pod postacią chleba i wina. Oczekujemy jak pielgrzymi na spotkanie z Bogiem, a Eucharystia jest naszym pożywieniem, jest chlebem wędrowców, którzy po trudach będą uczestniczyć w uczcie niebieskiej. Eucharystia jest zadatkiem naszego życia wiecznego: "Ja jestem chlebem żywym, który zstąpił z nieba. Jeśli kto spożywa ten chleb, będzie żył na wieki" (*J 6, 51*). (*o. Stefan Tuszyński*)

<u>PIERWSZY PIĄTEK:</u> 7-go czerwca przypada pierwszy piątek miesiąca czerwca. Po Mszy Św. o godzinie 9-ej rano (po angielsku), będzie wystawienie Najświętszego Sakramentu do godziny 7-ej wieczorem, i Błogosławieństwo. Po Błogosławieństwie, będzie dodatkowa Msza Św. <u>po polsku</u> (o godzinie 7:10). Będzie też okazja do spowiedzi świętej od godziny 6:00 do 6:45.
