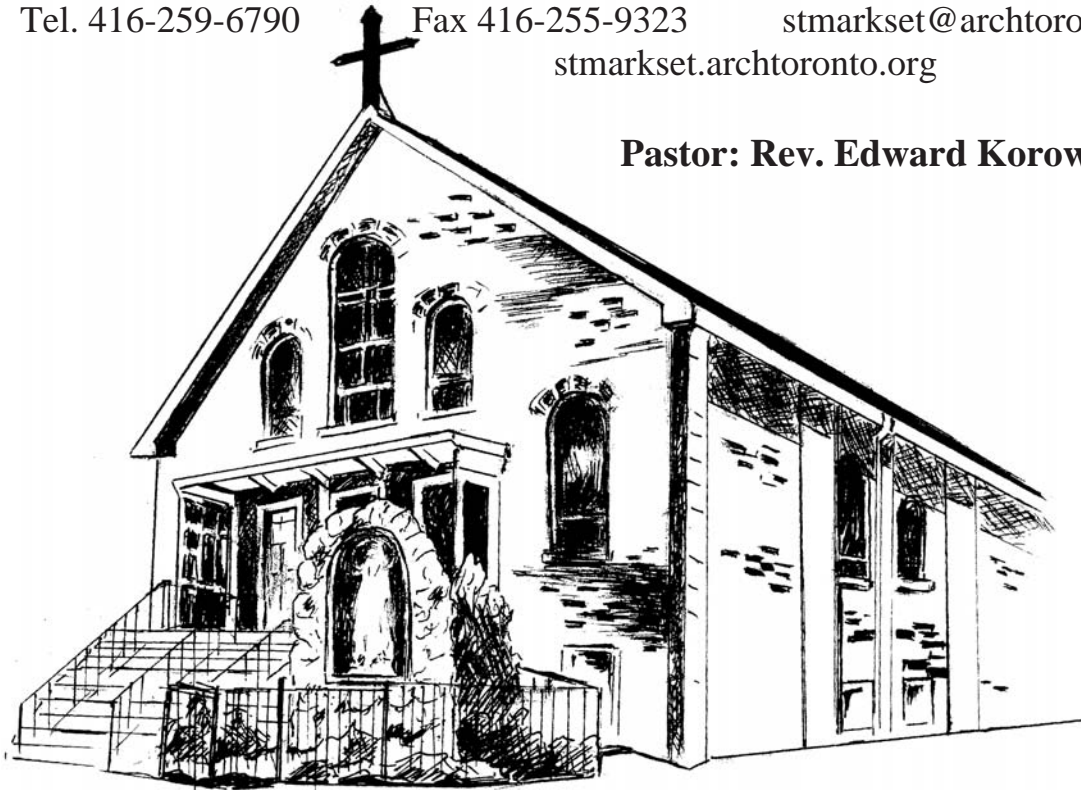

JESUS THE GOOD SHEPHERD (July 21). In today's Gospel, we get a glimpse into the heart of Jesus as the Good Shepherd. After the Apostles had returned from their ministry, Jesus invites the Apostles go to a deserted place to rest a while. Yet even in this deserted place, a crowd follows Jesus and seeks Him out. The crowd was desperate to be with the Lord, for they sought the truth he proclaimed and the healing of body and soul that he provided. When Jesus looked at the crowd who sought him out in the deserted place, he was moved for he saw a people who "were like a sheep without a shepherd."

Jesus continues to look at us and be moved in the same way he was in the Gospel. Are we aware of Christ's gaze on us today? When Jesus sees our heart, he sees our hunger, our thirst, and all the aspects of our life that cause us despair and he seeks to give us repose. As St. Paul says to the Ephesians, "He is our peace." Christ wishes to feed and nourish us just as he did for the crowd in the Gospel. ...

GOD CANNOT BE OUTDONE IN GENEROSITY. (**July 28**) The readings today should remind us of a simple truth - God cannot be outdone in generosity. In the Gospel, we hear of people who followed Jesus to be nourished by him spiritually, yet little did they know that the Son of God would go even further and provide for even their physical needs. When the people were hungry and had nothing to eat, it was the offering of a child, a meager offering of five barley loaves and two fish which would be multiplied by Jesus so that all five thousand people would be fed. The small offering of the boy through Jesus' hands was transformed to be more than enough food for all five thousand people, so much so that there were twelve baskets of food left over.

This story of the multiplication of the loaves and fish remind us of a very particular and beautiful moment in the Eucharistic celebration. During the offertory, we present to the Lord our gifts, bread and wine, and just as Jesus performs a miracle in the Gospel, He takes our small offering and transforms them into His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity for us to be nourished by.

When we come to Mass, at the offertory, what gifts are we offering to the Lord? Just as Jesus transforms bread and wine to His body and blood, God wishes to take whatever gift we offer to Him, whether it be our time or talent, and multiply it for the sake of those we share our gifts with. Let us spend some time and reflect on the ways which God is calling us to share our gifts. Whatever we give to the Lord with a generous and giving heart, God will not let go to waste, for He is a God that cannot be outdone in generosity. (source: archtoronto.org/stewardship)

XVI Niedziela w ciągu roku – B (28-go lipca)

Dobry Pasterz. Pan Jezus mówi, że jest Dobrym Pasterzem – ogłasza, że w Nim spełnia się zapowiedź mesjańska. On będzie realizował to, co Bóg zapowiedział przez proroków. Troszczy się On o wszystkie ich potrzeby, także o odpoczynek. Gdy ujrzał wielki tłum, który szedł wszędzie za Nim, zdjęła Go litość. Byli bowiem jak owce nie mające pasterza. I zaczął ich nauczać.

Jaka powinna być nasza odpowiedź na miłość Jezusa, na pragnienie poznania Go i na wymóg wiernego zachowania Jego nauki? Tylko On jest Drogą, Prawdą i Życiem. Przyłgnąć do Niego to również słuchać głosu tych, których pozostawił nam jako swych przedstawicieli. Oni – w Jego imieniu – są dzisiaj naszymi pasterzami.

W przyszłą niedzielę (28-go lipca), zbierana będzie druga kolektka na fundusz renowacyjny Kościoła. Specjalne koperty niebieskie na ten cel są wyłożone na stolikach przy wejściu do Kościoła. Z góry bardzo wam dziękuję za ofiary przeznaczone na ten cel. Bóg zapłać, i niech was Bóg błogosławi!

Będzie też okazja do spowiedzi świętej od godziny **6:00 do 6:45** wieczorem, i Błogosławieństwo o godz. **7:00**. Po Błogosławieństwie będzie dodatkowa Msza Św. po polsku o godz. 7:10.

XVII Niedziela w ciągu roku – B (7-go sierpnia)

Troszczcie się nie o ten pokarm, który ginie. Jesteśmy bardzo często jak ludzie z dzisiejszej Ewangelii, szukający Chrystusa dla swoich przyziemnych celów. Spragnieni raczej doczesności i szukający zaspokojenia naszych materialnych potrzeb nie zwracamy uwagi na coś głębszego i (dla naszych zgłodniałych oczu) zakrytego. Troszczymy się bardzo o ten chleb, który ginie, troszczymy się bardzo o doczesność. Ale czy czasami nie zapominamy o czymś daleko ważniejszym? Troszczymy się za bardzo o ten chleb, który ginie, zaniedbując jednocześnie coś daleko ważniejszego. Łakniemy i pragniemy, pożądamy i nie mamy, ... i stale biedni jesteśmy i stale ubodzy, stale głodni i nienasyчени.

Dlaczego tak łatwo wierzymy wszystkim "doczesnym prorokom" obiecującym nam ziemski, doczesny raj, a tak trudno jest nam uwierzyć i zaufać Chrystusowi? Troszczymy się bardzo o pokarm, który ginie i który nasycić nie może, a lekceważymy sobie niemal całkowicie pokarm, który daje życie wieczne.
