

<u>A LIVING FAITH.</u> "What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but do not have works?" In our second reading from the Letter of James we are challenged to have a living faith, a faith that is backed up by action. ...

While prayer and our relationship with Christ should always remain the most important aspect of our lives, it should still lead us to take action. This is the life of a steward. Before we can bring Jesus to others, our hearts must be filled with His love through our prayer and frequent reception of the Eucharist. We can only give what we have first received.

Moreover, we should always realize that the most generous and loving thing we can do for someone is pray for them. This is the humbling reality of being a disciple. It is not our own merits that bring about change but rather God's mercy and providence. Therefore, we should always turn to intercessory prayer before we take any action. However, after entrusting everything to God, we can then play our part and concretely try to help. For example, St. James cautions us against only praying for people who are hungry while not actually offering some

of our food. The prayer is essential, but as stewards, we must strive to offer tangible support as well. Let us take some time to reflect on how we can better put our faith into action through proper use of our time and talents. (source: www.archtoronto.org/stewardship)

## Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be administered in our parish on **Saturday**, **April 26**, **2025**, at the **5:00 p.m.** Mass. Students in *Grade 7 or older*, and any adults who wish to be confirmed should attend one of the weekend Masses, and obtain a registration form from Fr. Koroway afterwards. The form lists the dates of the four preparation meetings the candidates and their parents must attend on Saturday mornings in the Church. The deadline for returning the registration form is **Sunday**, **November 17**.



FIRST CONFESSION AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: Parents of students in Grade 2 or older who would like their children to receive these sacraments this coming year should attend one of the weekend Masses with their children, and obtain a registration form from Fr. Koroway afterwards. The form lists the six preparation meetings the students and parents must attend in the Church on Saturday mornings. The deadline for returning the registration forms is Sunday, October 27.

## XXIV Niedziela w ciągu roku – B

Dzisiejszy fragment Ewangelii składa się z trzech części. Pierwszą stanowi wyznanie św. Piotra. Gdy Chrystus pytał swych uczniów o to, za kogo Go ludzie uważają, padły odpowiedzi, które odzwierciedlały panujące wówczas o Nim opinie. Wtedy znów zapytał: "A wy za kogo Mnie uważacie?". W imieniu wszystkich Piotr wyznał: "Ty jesteś Mesjaszem".

Drugą część stanowi nauczanie Jezusa mówiące o tym, co Go jako Mesjasza spotka: "Syn Człowieczy musi wiele cierpieć (...), będzie zabity, ale po trzech dniach zmartwychwstanie". Jezus użył tu słowa "musi", zaznaczając w ten sposób, że czekające Go męka i zmartwychwstanie należą mesjańskiego posłannictwa. Jednakże św. Piotr zaprotestował przeciwko temu, ulegajac wyobrażeniom o Mesjaszu, który miał przywrócić królestwo Izraela, głównie w sensie politycznym. Jezus gwałtownie zareagował na jego słowa: "Zejdź mi z oczu, szatanie". Ostrość Jego słów wynikała z odwieść tego. Piotr próbował Go urzeczywistnienia mesjańskiego posłannictwa.

Trzecia część Ewangelii mówi natomiast o sytuacji uczniów Chrystusa. Nie tylko bowiem Jezus jako Mesjasz musiał cierpieć. Ponieważ żaden uczeń nie jest ponad Mistrza, nikt nie może uchylić się od tego, by Go naśladować — nawet, gdyby to wiązało się z cierpieniem. Jezus nie pozostawił nam w tym względzie żadnych wątpliwości: "Jeśli kto chce pójść za Mną, niech się zaprze samego siebie, niech weźmie krzyż swój i niech Mnie naśladuje". A przecież wszyscy uczniowie na mocy chrztu świętego stanowią "lud mesjański".

W przyszłą niedzielę, zbierana będzie druga kolekta na fundusz renowacyjny Kościoła. Specjalne koperty niebieskie na ten cel są wyłożone na stolikach przy wejściu do Kościoła. Z góry bardzo wam dziękuję za ofiary przeznaczone na ten cel.

Święty Michale Archaniele, wspomagaj nas w walce, a przeciw niegodziwości i zasadzkom złego ducha bądź naszą obroną. Oby go Bóg pogromić raczył, pokornie o to prosimy, a Ty, Wodzu niebieskich zastępów, szatana i inne duchy złe, które na zgubę dusz ludzkich po tym świecie krążą, mocą Bożą strąć do piekła. Amen.


