

LOOKING TO OUR ROLE MODEL. As Christians, we are always called to seek ways of imitating Christ. The Catechism says that "in all of his life Jesus presents himself as our model. He is "the perfect man", who invites us to become his disciples and follow him." Jesus was also the perfect steward so we can constantly look to Him for guidance in our own commitment to stewardship.

However, many people may have reservations in trying to imitate Christ because it seems like an unattainable ideal. We may feel that Jesus, being God, doesn't know what it's like to struggle here on earth. However, this does not mean he didn't have to fight the same fight that we do in our path towards virtue.

St. Paul in his letter to the Hebrews says "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin." St. Paul beautifully shows us that Christ fully understands what our struggles and difficulties are. Although He never succumbed to temptations, He too would have faced the desire to despair or give up on His call to love and sacrifice for us. Therefore, when we face trials in our stewardship, let us turn to Jesus and ask Him to help us overcome our struggles just as He did during His time on earth. Stewardship is not an impossible ideal, we just need the strength and guidance of God.

<u>WŁADZA I SŁUŻBA.</u> Ewangelia dnia dzisiejszego przywołuje nam uczniów Jezusa: Jana i Jakuba, którzy pragnęli być blisko Chrystusa w Królestwie Bożym.

Prosili, aby jeden otrzymał miejsce po prawej, a drugi po lewej stronie tego, który już teraz ma władzę, a potem będzie ją miał w całej rozciągłości. Jednakże myśl Boża jest inna. Bóg kieruje losami świata i człowieka ponad czasem i daje inne wartości, niż te, do jakich przywykliśmy, i które sobie wyobrażamy na podstawie szczęścia ziemskiego.

Prorok Izajasz przepowiadał, że Mesjasz będzie cierpiał, ale po udrękach swej duszy otrzyma chwałę, tak że będzie w stanie usprawiedliwić wielu, bo weźmie na siebie ich nieprawości.

W takim razie zapytajmy, czy ma nas interesować władza czy służba? Jezus uczy drogi pokory, która prowadzi do wywyższenia. Kto chce być wielki, musi stać się najpierw sługą. Trzeba więc w drodze do wywyższenia naśladować Chrystusa: przecież On również przyszedł nie po to, żeby Mu służono, ale żeby służyć. W tej służbie oddał życie na okup za wielu. Czyż może być większy dar od daru życia? Dlatego władza, którą Bóg ma w sposób naturalny i która jest zwykłym Jego przywilejem, staje się udziałem każdego z nas, kiedy umiemy służyć. Mówimy, że służyć Bogu, znaczy królować — taka justo struktura i taka jest koncepcja królestwa, w którym Bóg wprowadza w nowe przymierze łaski, która zbawia i wywyższa. Skoro więc Chrystus służył, to chce, żebyśmy także i my służyli. (bp Jan Bernard Szlaga)


