

PEACE BE WITH YOU. The life of the Christian disciple is one that should be filled with great peace. However, peace does not mean the absence of difficulties or trials. Rather, true peace is living in joy despite the turbulences we may experience. We're reminded in the Gospel that we can only receive this peace from Jesus. He tells us, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives."

How does the world give peace? The world tells us that if we have lots of money in the bank, the fancy car, the extravagant house and the perfect looks, then we will be at peace. It promotes peace as something that is achieved through exterior possessions or circumstances. However, what does the world offer us when difficulties arise? How does the world teach peace in the midst of tough

financial situations or an unfavourable medical diagnosis? This is where the peace of Christ triumphs.

We can achieve a sense of interior peace despite the exterior sufferings when we fix our minds on things that are heavenly. We can always draw great strength from realizing our identity as beloved children of God. God loves us. This reality alone has the profound effect of easing the greatest of crosses. St. Teresa of Avila says: "Let nothing perturb you, nothing frighten you. All things pass. God does not change. Patience achieves everything." God is always faithful towards us. The next time we're in a moment that threatens to rob us of our peace, let us take a deep breath, call to mind the smiling gaze of Christ towards us, and pray, "Jesus I love you." VI Niedziela Wielkanocna – C

<u>NIEROZERWALNA WIĘŹ – DUCH ŚWIĘTY I</u> <u>MY.</u> Jezus nie zostawia nas w naszych konfliktach i rozdarciach. Jako ludzie toczymy różne walki i zmagania – ze sobą, w sobie, z innymi. A On posyła nam Ducha, dzięki któremu przez te konflikty – paradoksalnie – jesteśmy bliżej Prawdy.

Jak widzimy w dzisiejszym pierwszym czytaniu, poróżnienia zdarzały się już w Kościele pierwotnym. Kościół jednak się nie rozpadł, przeciwnie, w decyzjach i postanowieniach pojawił się Duch Święty, a przez Niego wszystko zaczęło iść w dobrym kierunku: "Postanowiliśmy bowiem, Duch Święty i my". Ta jedność apostołów z Duchem Świętym pozwala im być fundamentem wiary, dlatego w drugim czytaniu słyszymy: "A mur Miasta ma dwanaście warstw fundamentu, a na nich dwanaście dwunastu Apostołów Baranka". fundamentem naszej wiary jest nauka apostołów, bo istnieje ta nierozerwalna więź: "Duch Święty i my".

Właśnie tego Ducha nieustannie w Kościele wzywamy i zapraszamy, ponieważ rodzące się we wspólnocie spory wewnętrzne i zewnętrzne rozbijają nas, wprowadzają zamęt i niepokój. Dlatego w dzisiejszej Ewangelii słyszymy o wzajemnym powiązaniu obecności Ducha z pokojem, który daje nam Jezus: "A Pocieszyciel, Duch Święty, którego Ojciec pośle w moim imieniu, On was wszystkiego nauczy i przypomni wam wszystko, co wam powiedziałem. Pokój zostawiam wam, pokój mój daję wam. Nie tak, jak daje świat, Ja wam daję".

Wzywajmy więc Ducha Świętego, ilekroć w naszych wewnętrznych czy zewnętrznych konfliktach zawodzi nasza ludzka mądrość i pojawia się zamęt. On poprowadzi nas w dobrą stronę i zaprowadzi pokój. (ks. Adam Rybicki)
